Abstract The Arabidopsis Genome Initiative (AGI) population is a collection of 1000 accessions of *Arabidopsis thaliana* that have been sequenced and are available for genetic and genomic studies. In this study, we investigated the genetic diversity and population structure of the AGI population using 1000 simple sequence repeat (SSR) markers. The results showed that the AGI population is highly diverse, with a mean heterozygosity of 0.18. The population structure analysis revealed that the AGI population is composed of two main clusters, one of which is highly diverse and the other is less diverse. The results of this study provide valuable information for the genetic and genomic studies of *A. thaliana*.
